Duties

New members are asked to sign up for one duty in their first year in a support / learning capacity. All Adult members are expected to fulfill 2 Race Officer duties (OoD, AOO) or Sunday afternoon tea duties, and the adult members of a family membership 3 in total. Regular racers are expected to fulfill one extra duty

Kayaks, Canoes + SUP's

If the owner of a kayak, SUP or canoe is a member of Paddle UK and does not wish to keep their craft at the club no boat fee is payable. If they are not a member of the Paddle UK or wish to leave it at the club the 'Small Craft' fee is payable. Please record your Paddle UK number next to the craft details

Enter the craft's colour and all the wording that is visible on the hull in the Small Craft Registration section, as this will enable us to contact you in case of any difficulty, this may/will include the manufacturer and brand name e.g. ***Galaxy, Tandem Solo - Blue,***

Insurance

All craft ***[rigid and inflatable]*** must be protected by current third-party indemnity of no less than £3,000,000. Please sign for each boat to confirm you have current insurance which you will maintain to always cover the boat when it is at SSC. Paddle UK personal On The Water membership normally includes craft indemnity insurance. Please note Paddle UK Affiliation via SSC membership does not include craft indemnity insurance. It is your responsibility to check you have the required liability insurance throughout your time as a member of SSC.

Family membership

This is a scheme where not more than two adult members living at the same address or two adult members with any number of junior members living at the same or different addresses may, at the discretion of the General Committee, qualify for a reduced subscription.

Outboard Motors

Please note that SSC is a sailing club that allows sailing, paddling and rowing. Outboards may be used as a "get me home" facility in emergency but not as the prime mover.

General Data Protection Regulations

The information you supply will be held to maintain membership records and to facilitate the running of the club including but not exclusively for providing mailing lists for distributing club newsletters and other information to members (including details of events which may be of interest whether run by this or other sailing or social organisations). Information may be sent by email. Data will only be disclosed to other members of the Club and will not be kept longer than necessary after resignation from the club.
